Cross Connection Control - Appointment Request Notice

Dear Water Customer:

The City of Fraser has contracted with HydroCorp of Troy, MI to perform the State of Michigan mandated Cross Connection Control Program. Thank you in advance for your cooperation in this matter.

The purpose of the Cross Connection Control Program is to help eliminate possible contamination of the public water distribution system. There are two required components of the program; 1) site inspection and 2) testing of backflow prevention assemblies.

As part of this program, a survey of the internal water system at your property will be completed. Inspectors will be reviewing the water system from the point of entry, basement and on the outside of your home for connections that could possibly contaminate the water distribution system. There are <u>no fees</u> for the inspection(s). However, any costs associated with the replacement, modification (s), installation, and/or testing of backflow prevention assemblies is the responsibility of the property owner/manager and/or occupant.

Your first step is to visit <u>schedulemyinspection.net</u> to schedule an appointment at your earliest convenience. Your appointment needs to be scheduled no later than 5 business days from receiving this notice as inspectors will be in your area shortly. It is necessary that someone 18 years of age or older be present during the inspection. A valid signature will be required at the conclusion of the inspection.

Following the inspection, you will be notified in writing if plumbing modification(s) and/or testing of backflow prevention assemblies are necessary. We look forward to working with you in protecting the drinking water supply.
